

## District Vision

Prince George's County will be a GREAT school system recognized for providing education services which ensure that every student in our diverse school district graduates ready for college and careers in a global society.

We are confident that a thoughtful, strategic implementation of Naviance at the PGCPS pilot schools will assist the district in achieving its strategic goals. The focus will be on aligning Naviance activities to the College/Career Readiness pillar from the Promise of PGCPS: 100% of graduates will meet the requirements to enter a two-or four-year college, technical school, or the military; and/or will hold a license or certification enabling them to enter the workforce within 6 months of graduation.

## PGCPS Responsibilities

### **District/Central Office Responsibilities:**

- District continues to assess needs and provide professional development to staff to support the District's Naviance implementation goals
- District adheres to plan to communicate expectations, key data, and successes to school staff and district leadership team.
- District team attends regular meetings and allows opportunities for in-depth data analysis to track progress towards goals with Naviance team

### **School Level Responsibilities:**

- Schools will fully incorporate Naviance into their counseling programs and utilize the CCLR grade level activities below to monitor and track student progress towards college & career readiness.
- Schools will use Naviance eDocs to send supporting application materials to colleges
